Dr. Lam is a facial plastic surgeon who is double board certified by the American Board of Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery and the American Board of Otolaryngology-Head & Neck Surgery. He is the owner of the 27,000 sq.ft. Willow Bend Wellness Center and the José Eber salon. He has authored three major medical textbooks, *Comprehensive Facial Rejuvenation*, *Cosmetic Surgery of the Asian Face*, and *Complementary Fat Grafting* along with over 100 book chapters and scientific papers. He lectures monthly nationally and internationally with well over 100 lectures to date. He is the 2002 winner of the John Orlando Roe Research Prize for his research on skin rejuvenation. He graduated Valedictorian from Cistercian Preparatory School and with honors from Princeton University and Baylor College of Medicine. He completed his head & neck surgery residency at Columbia University and his fellowship in facial plastic surgery thereafter. He is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons and the American Academy of Facial Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery.
