Lip Advancement, Lip Lift, Lip Reduction (Preoperative)

A description of the procedure and the potential benefits were reviewed in detail. The limitations of surgery including a suboptimal aesthetic and functional result were discussed. We also discussed the material risks that include but are not limited to infection, scarring, need for further surgery, a resulting “gummy” smile, increased dental show, and asymmetry at rest or animation. The patient also recognizes that it will take several months before the ultimate cosmetic result is apparent. However, this end result was not offered in any way as a guarantee. This patient had all questions answered and appears to understand the details, limitations, ramifications and complications as we have discussed. I believe this patient is very interested in proceeding with surgery.
